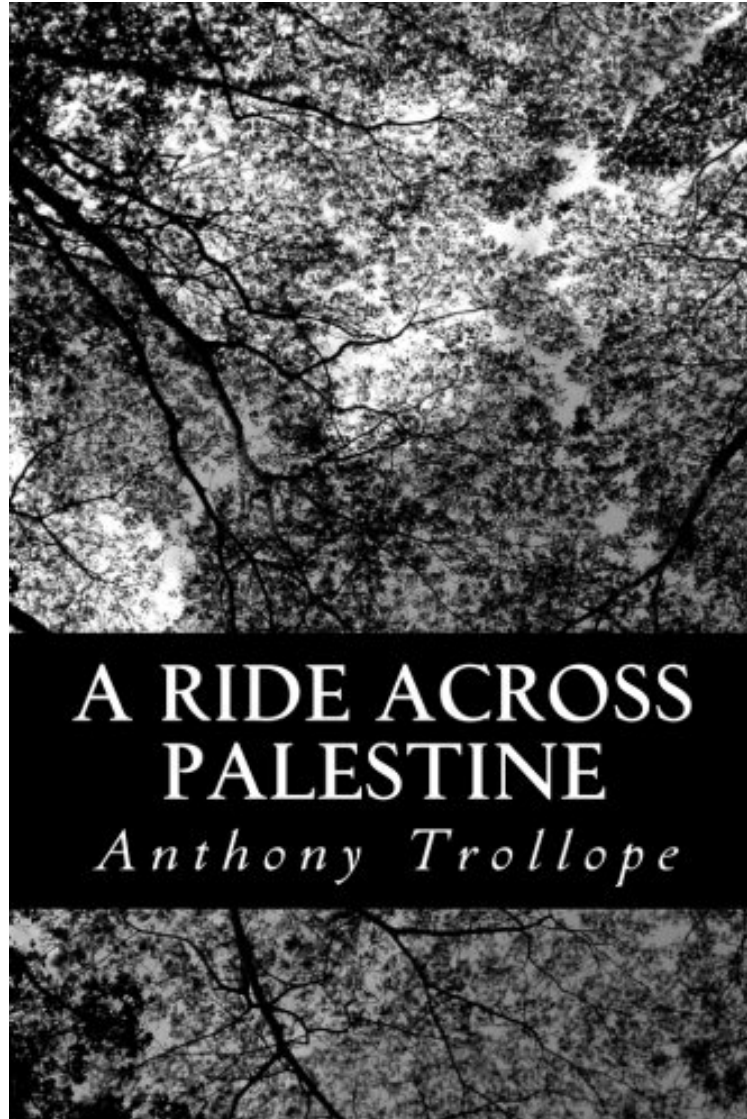

He tells about a man who wanted to see Palestine, but disliked

touring by himself. A "Mr. Smith" came to his hotel and told him that he also did not like traveling alone and offered to join him. The two were together for six days. The description of Palestine in the 1860s, the condition of the land and the Arabs there is no mention of Jews is interesting.
