As is acknowledged in all of Mayle's work, food is the constant and ultimate character. As has been written on the book covers, "Have a baguette or two on hand." "Like an excellent meal at a beloved restaurant, you'll savor every morsel. . . ." Reading this novel right now, my problem is that I have a vicious flu-like cold and cannot swallow a saltine much less "delectable dining." Having read "The Marseille Caper" which was published in 2012-2013, "Anything Considered" comes across as the heavier, more complex and meatier of the two. This is literally so. "Anything Considered" is a hefty 303 pages. "Marseille," the later book is almost 100 pages shorter at 210 pages. "The Corsican Caper," (2014) weighs in at 162 pages. Is this a progressing case of "He bag production. . ."? According to my calculations, "Anything Considered" is about the fifth of these types of Mayle's work. Even if you skip ahead chronologically a bit, the script is familiar, but nonetheless interesting as newer novels are published. The hero, the girl, the villain and the supporting cast and usual suspects. For those Mayle novels which I have yet to read such as, what appears to be his latest (2014) "The Corsican Caper," I look forward. These are excellent bedtime relaxants to help you get war, business, biography, philosophy and the rest of the "heavy lifting" out of your mind for the night.
