Ended up using our Marco Polo map for all purposes. I think the NG map is better for inspiring your trip and helping you decide, "visualize", your route in advance, but you should have a Michelin or Marco Polo quality map for actual nagivation purposes (of course GPS helped while we were en route, but we used our "big map" to determine how WE wanted to travel and then used GPS to help us stay on our chosen route.8 of 8 people found the following review helpful.
