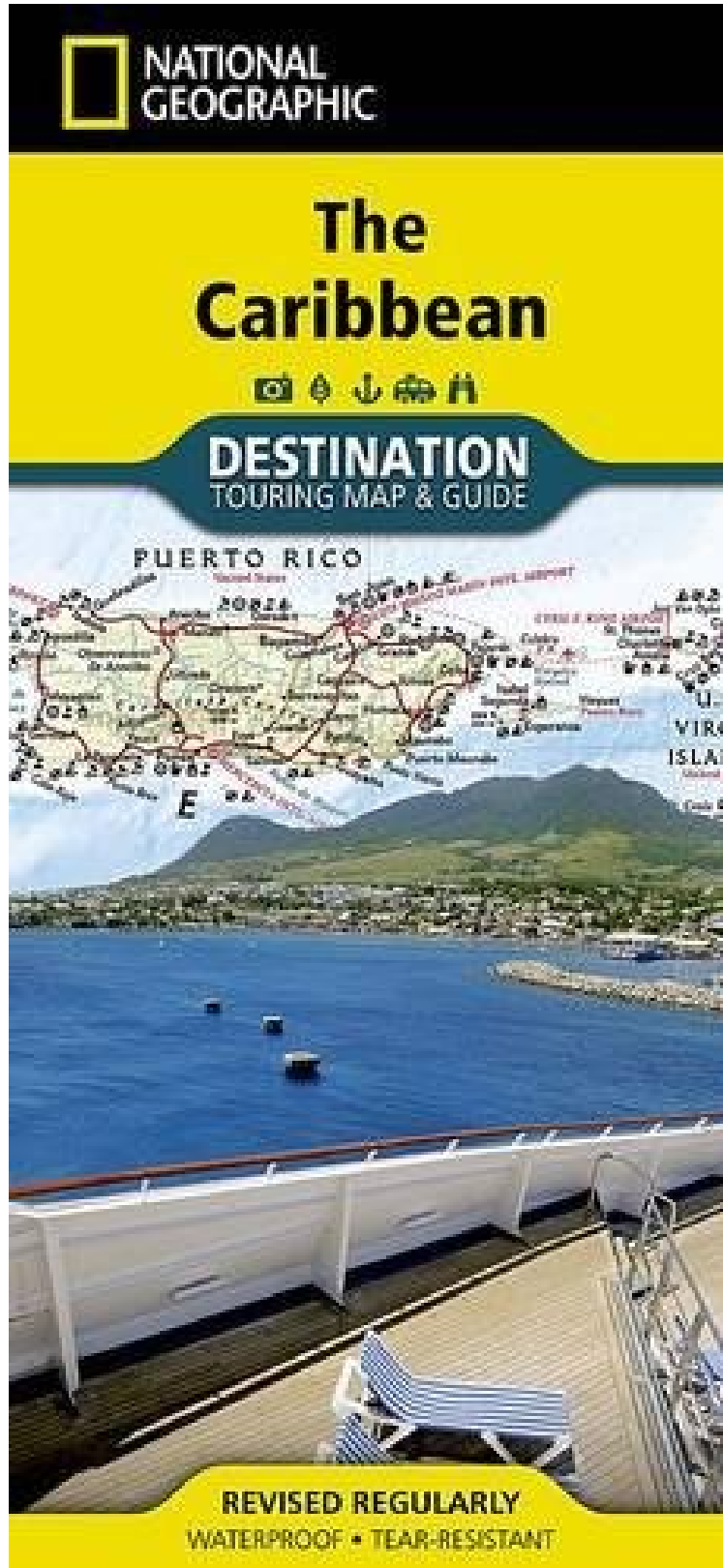

Quality printing but flawed design By Brus Laguna High quality printing you would expect from National Geographic, but overall design is flawed by a cluttered arrangement of inset boxes and photos that belong in a travel guide book, not a map. There is a scarcity of quality maps of the Caribbean and I'm still searching for one with both detail and coverage of the surrounding coasts of Mexico, Central and South America. Key cities and geographic detail of those areas are critical to studies of the exploration, conquest, wars, trade, buccaneering and colonization of all the Caribbean islands. Sticking insets of meaningless travel tips and photos to cover important geography I found useless and irritating. Inset maps for Nassau, Bahamas; George Town, Cayman Islands; Old Havana, Cuba are included. Every Destination Map is printed on durable synthetic paper, making them waterproof, tear-resistant and tough capable of withstanding the rigors of any kind of travel.
