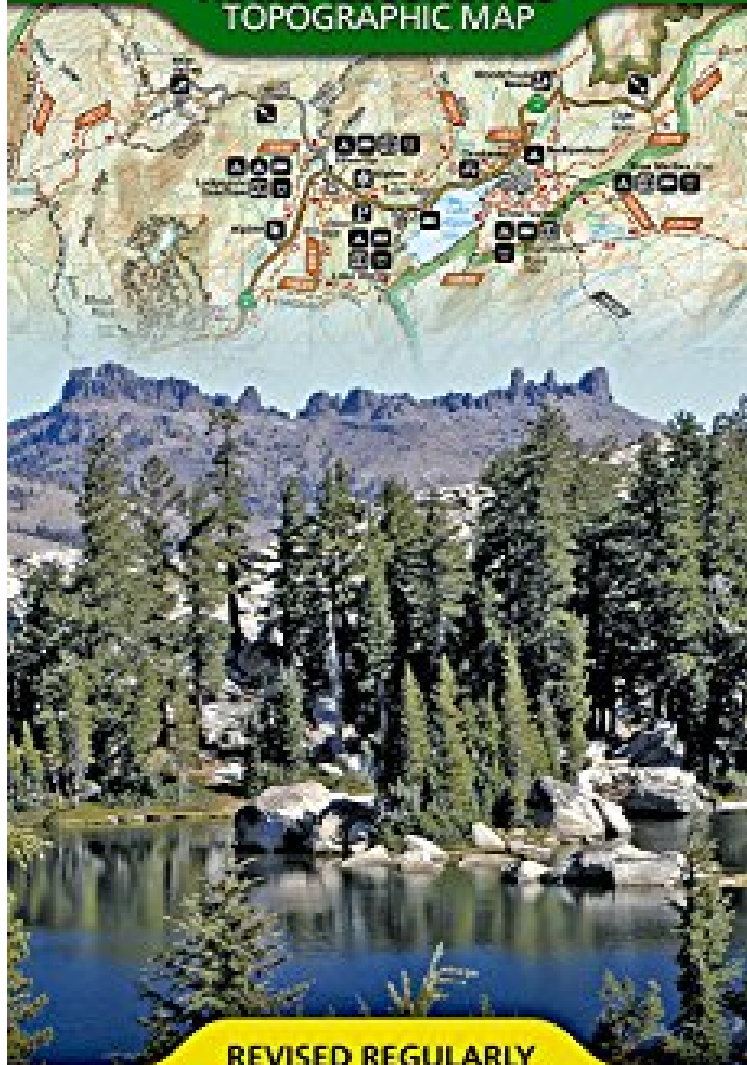

I hiked from Highland Lakes to Asa Lake and while this map has the Pacific Crest Trail to the left of Lake Asa, this is not the case. The Pacific Crest trail is to the right of Lake Asa. If i cannot trust this map for a quick day hike there is no way I will trust it for a full blown backpacking trip. See for yourself, look up Lake Asa on google maps and check against this map...
