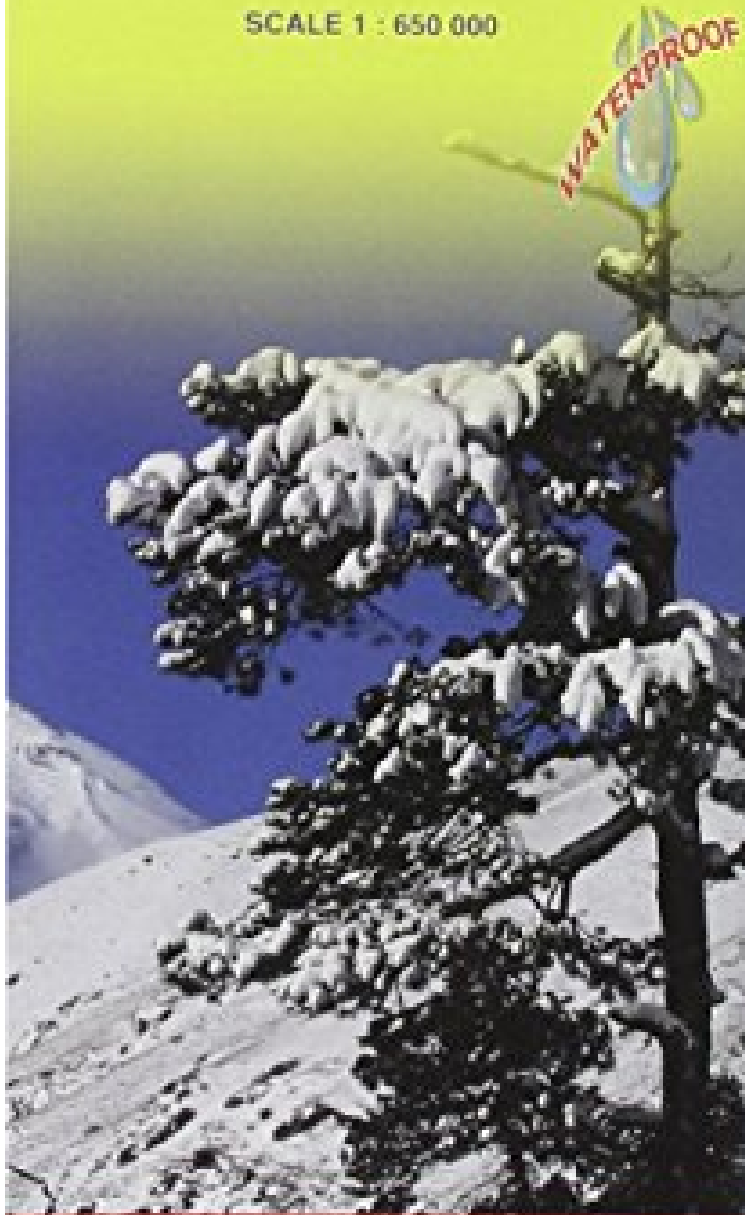

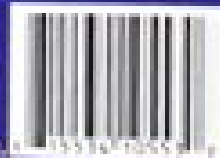

It includes a fair amount of Turkey. Probably best to carry with you. ITM is on regular paper and has a large index and more detail. In the north it cuts off south of Derbent and just north of Vladikavkaz, so it is incomplete. Probably best for home use. The Gizi Map has a cardboard cover, lightly coated paper, a large index on the back and slightly more detail. There seem to be two versions and this refers to the one with the mountain on the cover.
