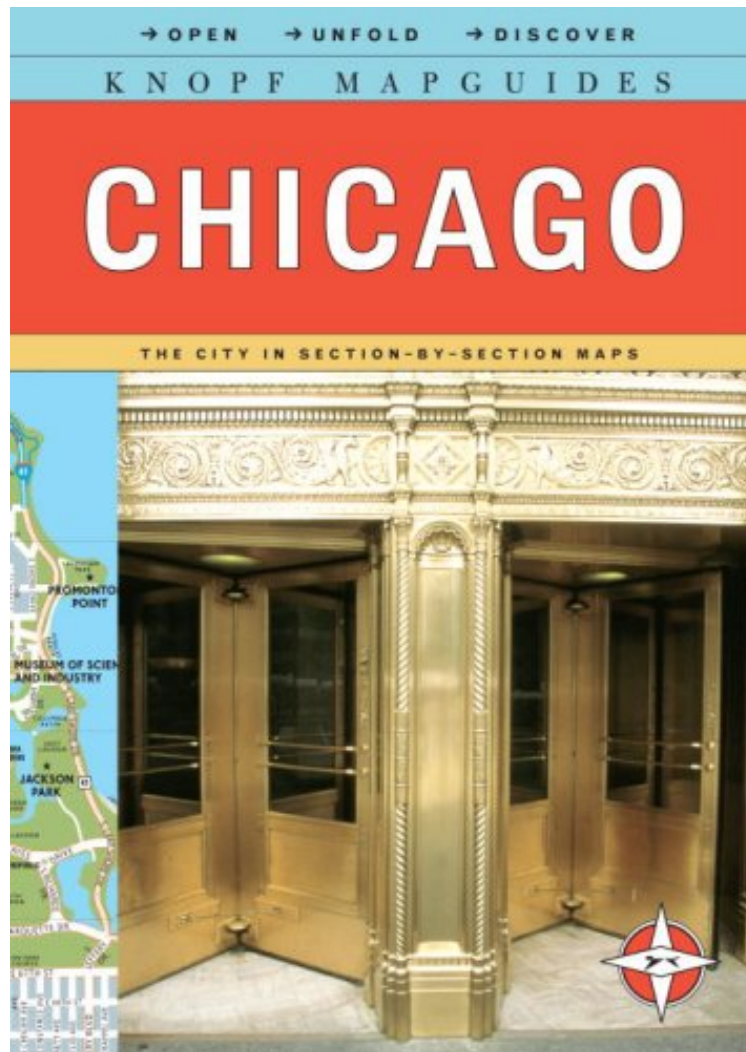

The multiple pages of foldout maps are far better than the single pop-ups or small single foldouts in some guides. They map and describe the key historic, cultural, architectural features and shopping areas you want to see within a few days and they have great maps for getting around on foot.
