Chile Zona Central 1:400,000 Travel Map city plans, waterproof, GPS-compatible #4 This map is double-sided to provide the best balance between a good scale and a convenient sheet size (size 99 x 69 cm / 39" x 27"). It is waterproof and tear-resistant. One side presents a regional road map at scale 1:400,000 (1 inch = 6.3 miles) extending from just above 32° to just beyond 34°15' south. Coverage includes the Paso Internacional Los Libertadores (Cristo Redentor) mountain pass and the Aconcagua Provincial Park in Argentina. It shows many more locations than general maps of the whole country. The map provides an exceptionally vivid picture of the terrain, using satellite imagery as a base, with shading and altitude colouring, plus plenty of names of mountain ranges, peaks, passes, salt flats, etc. National parks and other protected areas are prominently highlighted. Classification of the road network indicates dirt roads and tracks, as well as hard and soft 4WD roads, and shows locations of border crossings, gas stations, toll booths and police units. Driving distances are marked on main and selected secondary routes. Railway lines are included and local airports/aerodromes are marked. A range of symbols indicate various places of interest and areas for recreational activities, including tourist information offices, UNESCO World Heritage and other cultural or historical sites,

beaches, hot springs, trekking and skiing areas, etc. The map has a latitude and longitude grid at 15' intervals, a place name index and a distance table. On the reverse is an overview map of Santiago (highway system), with an enlargement of the city centre and a diagram of the metro network, plus street plans of Valparaso and Via del Mar. Map legend includes Spanish and English. Authentic, reliable Chilean cartography.
