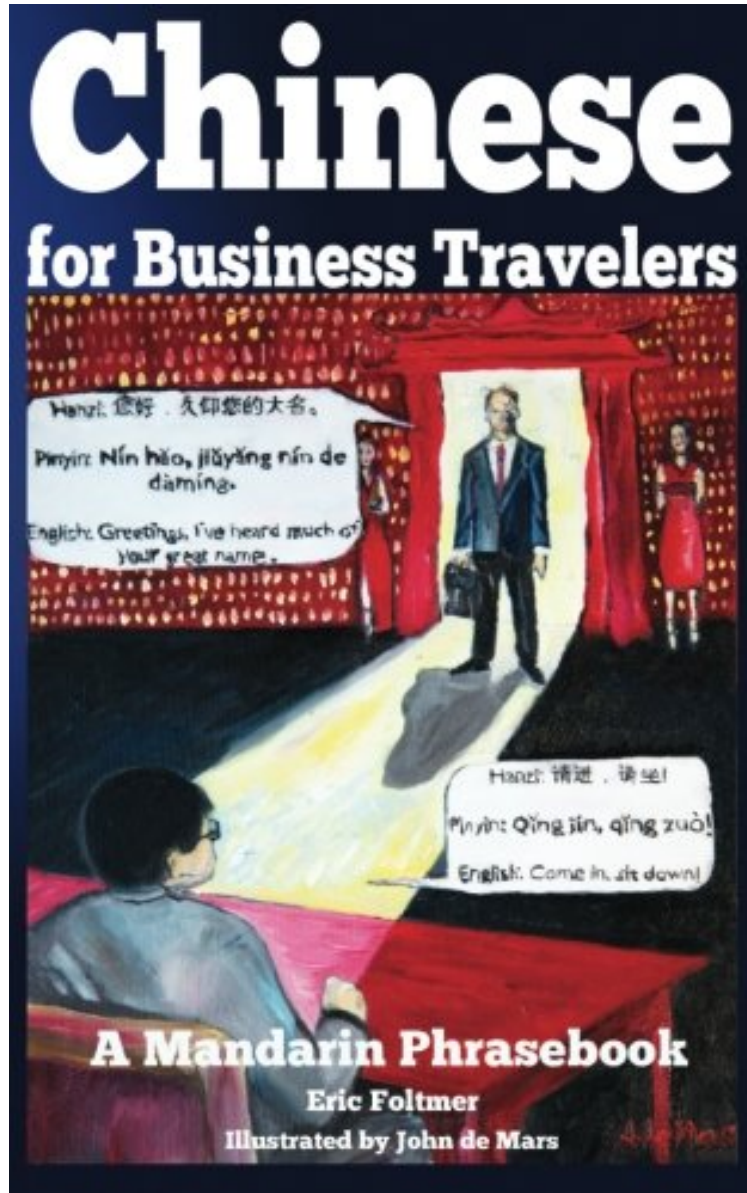

"nshu din" for the pronunciation (using pinyin). The characters shown are actually pronounced "minshu". "nshu" might sound like a stilted way of saying "I sleep". Not a good way to talk about duty free items upon arrival in China. This is sloppy editing, and advanced students of Chinese will spot these mistakes easily. However, this is going to cause problems for beginners. Too bad.
