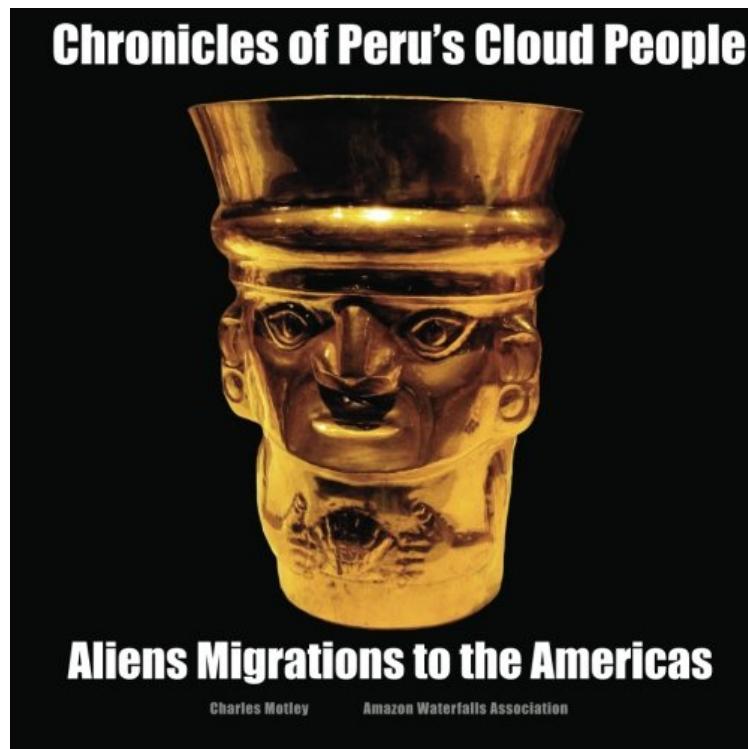


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## Chronicles of Peru's Cloud People: Polynesian Migrations to the Americas (Volume 1)

With its recent access it has the most unfolding discoveries, despite being overlooked by professionals. These include a waterfall about 3 times as high as the Eiffel Tower discovered in 2007, many ongoing mummy discoveries, lost fortified stone wall villages proliferating the mountain tops, medical plants, ancient Fortress Kuelap, the largest building structure of the Americas. exotic endangered species and the only untouched truly pristine jungle and natives of Peru. The author, Charles Motley recognized it to be the best combination ecological and archaeological zone of the America when he went

there 25 years ago, even before it was accessible to tourists. He built lodges for the villages near the best ruins to give them an incentive to protect this pristine environment. His non-profit volunteer project now is building the worlds best ecological trek on a sheer cliff ledge, passing 7 gigantic waterfalls, 4 higher than any of the continental USA, containing 5 of the worlds most exotic endangered species.
