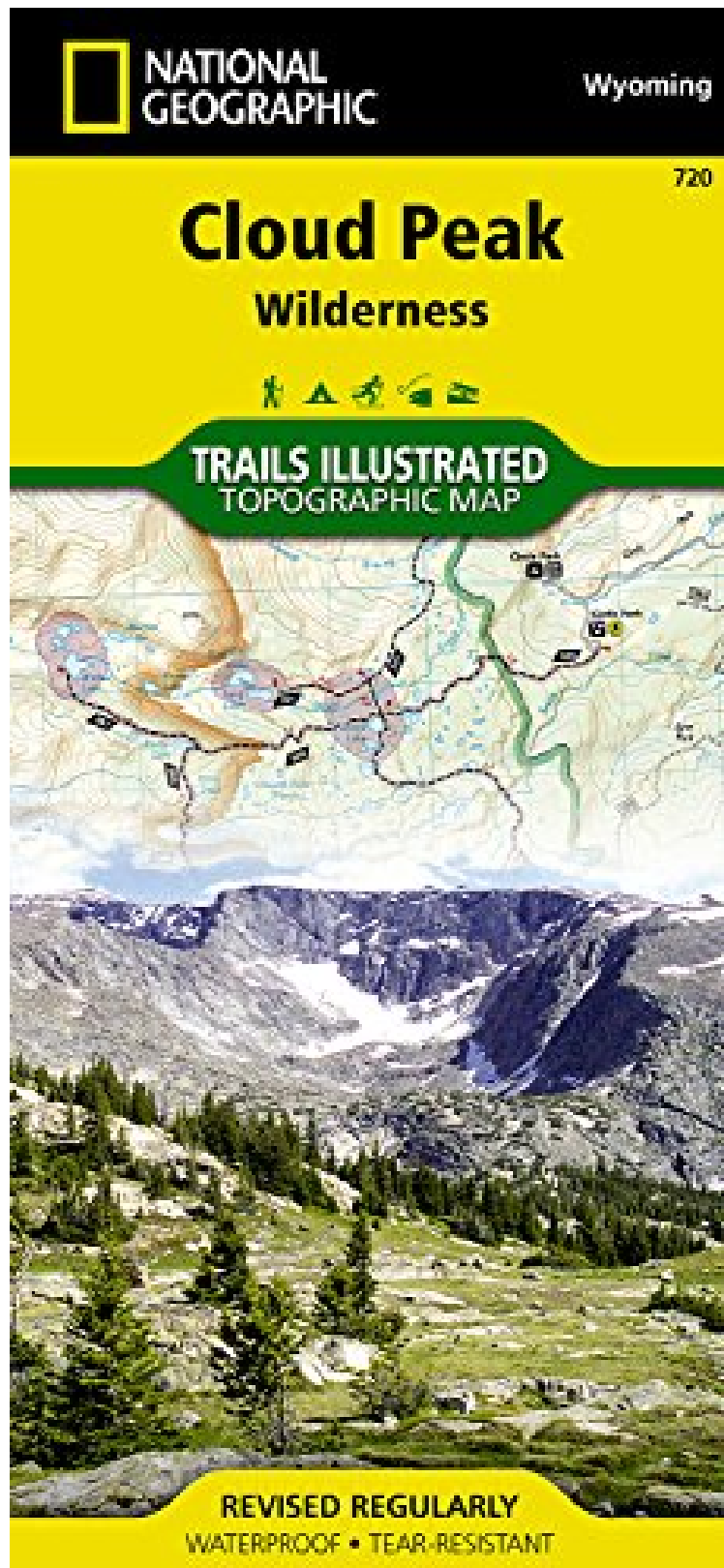

It was very easy to plan routes, estimate elevation gain/loss, locate landmarks, etc. with its clear topo lines and mileage markings on the trail sections. High use zones, usually around certain lakes are highlighted as well. Camping guides list the areas campgrounds, with each one's elevation, facilities, size and usage. Other recreation features on the map include hiking registration boxes, fishing areas, alpine and cross-country ski areas, boat launch points and scenic viewpoints. Every Trails Illustrated map is printed on "Backcountry Tough" waterproof, tear-resistant paper. A full UTM grid is printed on the map to aid with GPS navigation. Other features found on this map include: Bighorn Mountains, Bighorn National Forest, Black Tooth Mountain, Cloud Peak, Cloud Peak Wilderness.
