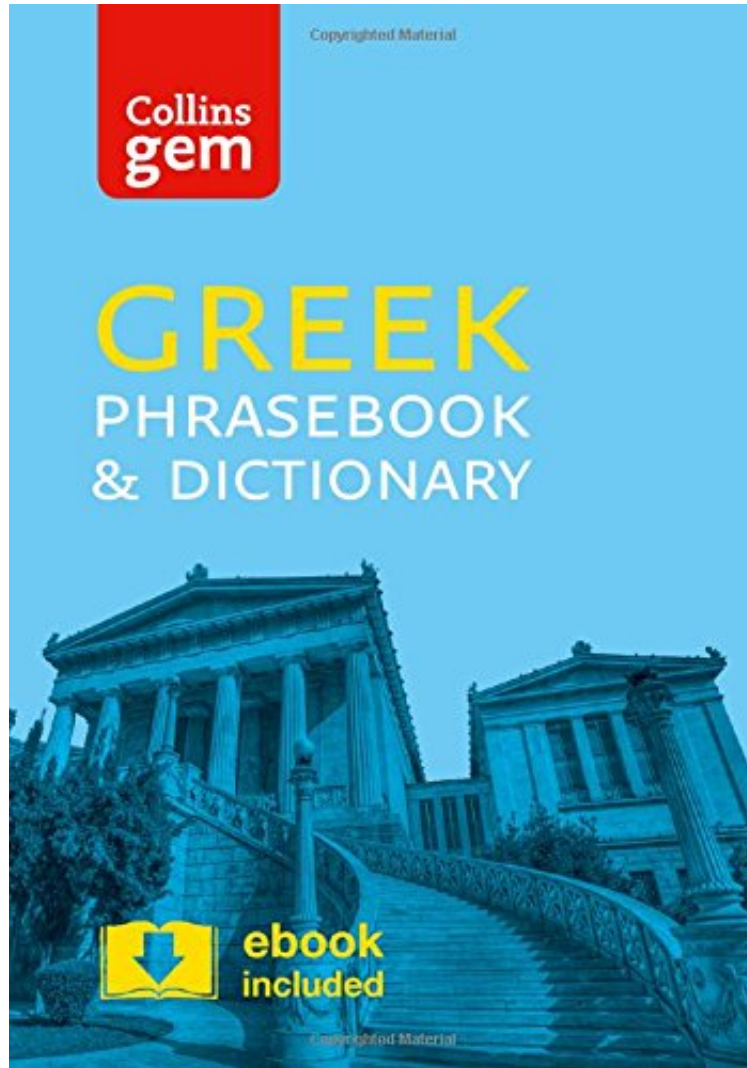

Just what I neededBy o2btravlingHaving the Kindle edition made it always available, and being able to search for terms in it made it easy to use (just highlight, press SEARCH, and multiple occurrences are found through the book when using my Samsung Android phone), both in English and in the native Greek !Having the menu reader section was helpful in figuring out menus when I was on vacation this past autumn in Crete; but do note that it is in Greek alphabetical order (alpha [Α], beta [Β], gamma, delta [Δ]. . .); you'll catch on quick, the Greek alphabet is the first things covered the first unit of the book. It has a limited (but handy)

grammar section (fun for language geeks like me) in the back along with a English - Greek / Greek - English glossary too. The table of contents doesn't use the book's color coding, but each unit has its own three tone (black, white, and the unit's relevant color), and you can always go back to the table of contents if you need to find a sub-section in that unit. Helpful for practical basics (numbers, shopping, request ("I need. . .", "I would like. . ." and courtesies).
