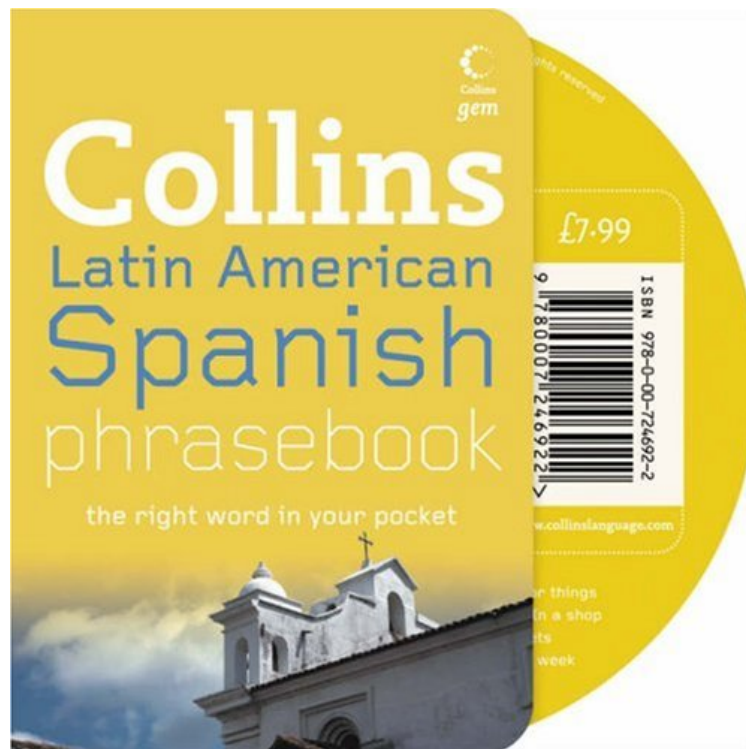

Great phrasebook for travellingBy Livingroom AthleteI had been looking around for a phrasebook to take with us to Buenos Aires, but struggled with the pros and cons of various other publications. We had taken Lonely Planet to Germany, and while we found the colour coded pages useful, too much space (and space = pages = size) is spent on phrases we don't really need while travelling (e.g. the section of pick-up lines caused much laughter at home, but wasn't that useful when we were there) and there wasn't any real mention of grammar. The Berlitz Italian phrasebook was useful and to the point, but didn't have colour coding, so lots of time was spent trying to find the right section.I purchased Collins Latin American Spanish without having ever seen a Collins phrasebook, but it sounded like it ticked all the boxes. And it does!! Phonetic pronunciation is included for the words and phrases, it's colour coded, there's a wonderful grammar

section as well as both an English-Spanish dictionary and a Spanish-English dictionary. And because it keeps to those words and phrases you're most likely to need, it's also a wonderfully small size (without the need to squint at the pages). The CD is also useful. The only potential downside is that the words and phrases are read out without any particular order (in relation to the pages of the phrasebook itself). So, there are different sections (basics, food, etc), but the order words/phrases are read out in within that section isn't necessarily what you're reading straight from the page. But as people in real life don't say exactly what is on the page, maybe it's useful to tune your ear rather than rely on being able to read the word at the same time. I would highly recommend this to anyone needing a phrasebook, and I plan to use the Collins phrasebook series for any future phrasebook purchases.

With an accompanying CD that makes oral practice possible, this reference ensures that the right word will always be at the reader's fingertips.
