There weren't many reviews for maps, so I ended up purchasing this map, the DestinationMap by National Geographic, and the GlobeTrotter travel map, figuring I'd get all three, and work it out once I got there. IMHO, this map was the best of the three.For what it's worth, all the maps I got were waterproof, and it turned out to be a big deal, b/c it was raining the entire time I was there. I really needed a no-frills map, without tourist factoids / filler on it. This was the only map out of the three that fit the bill - no huge legends which take up half the space, no history of Christ the Redeemer, Sugar Loaf, Tijuca forest or Botanical Gardens, just the map. When folded up, one side is the cover in the picture, but the other side is the Brazilian metro subway map. When I was trying to navigate the metro system (definitely the easiest way to get around), I didn't have to unfold a map 5x in order to figure out where I was going. Muito bom! Facile Facile!Additionally, what I liked was that this map was huge, but clearly detailed, one side being Rio de Janeiro, and the other side being the east coast of Brazil. It folded up small, but once unfolded, I could really see the city clearly,

and it was easy to figure out how to navigate around. I did get lost a few times, but whenever I found a sign, I was able to open the map and get my bearings b/c it outlined Rio de Janeiro down to the smallest streets and corridors. This map definitely saved me on multiple occasions from wandering into the wrong part of town. I would recommend that any person traveling from the US to Rio de Janeiro for the first time, bring:(1) this map, and(2) this dictionary:
