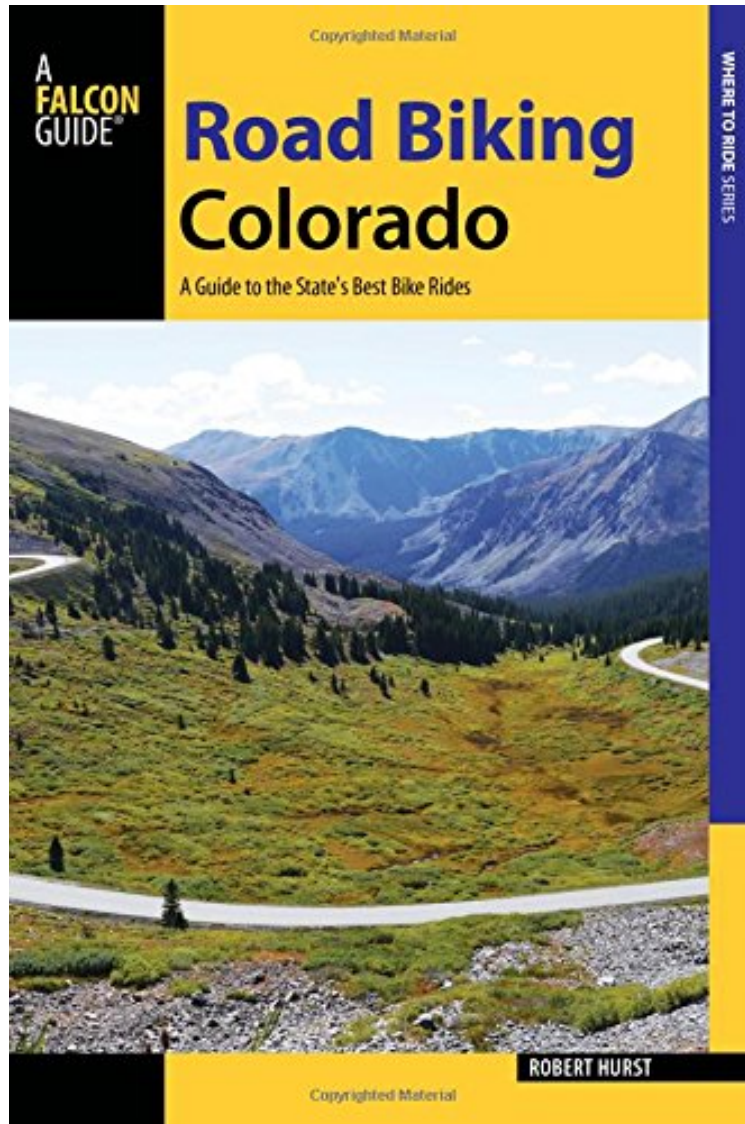

borders on plagiarism. This book gives a keyhole view to road biking in Colorado with only 400 miles worth of routes. Lackluster writing, lazy formatting, and no elevation profiles combine to form a book which isn't worth \$5 let alone \$25. I ended up returning this book and getting my money back. I would highly suggest getting Road Biking Colorado by Michael Seeberg which is absolutely succinct in describing the scope and breadth of what is available to both the novice and expert cyclist in Colorado, Mr. Seeberg's book is the definitive guide to Road Biking in Colorado.

Road Biking Colorado features 40 of the state's best road biking routes, from the foothills of Boulder to the red cliffs of Grand Junction. Complete with GPS coordinates, detailed mile-by-mile directions, history and intimate details of what you'll see along the way, this guide is perfect for the recreational rider who loves to read.
