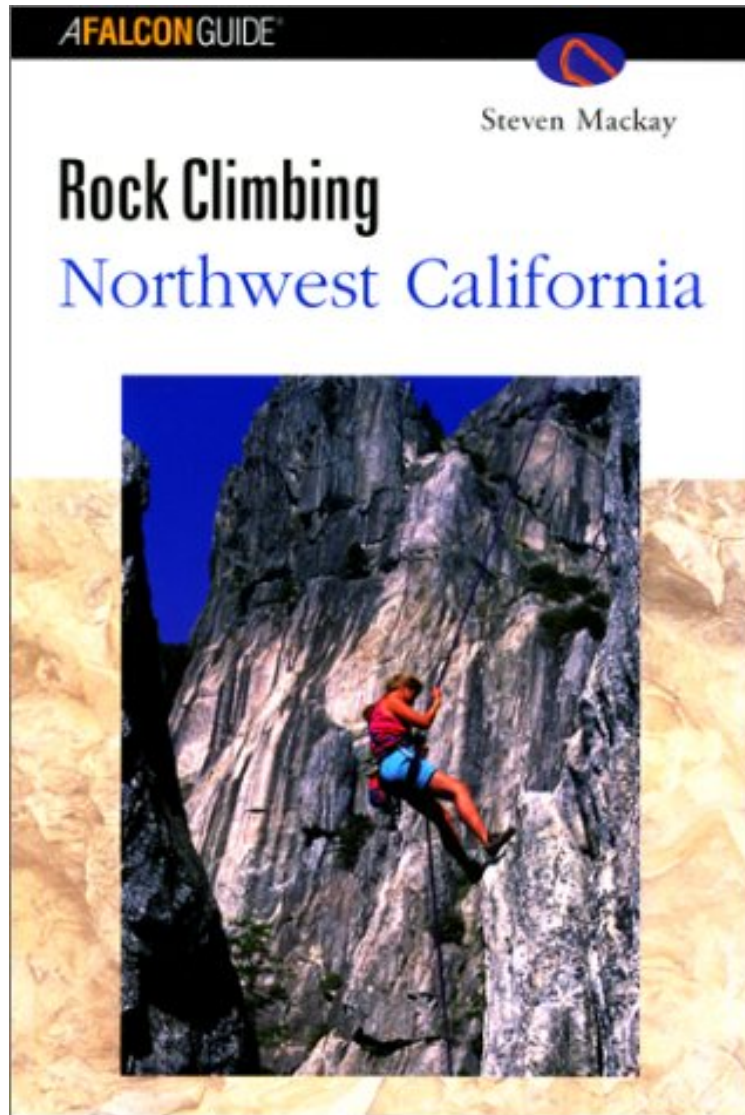

These areas include climbing at limestone and seaside cliffs in north western California. Please come to our crags but don't use this guide. Locally produced guides are more accurate and written by those who developed and actually sent routes at these crags.
