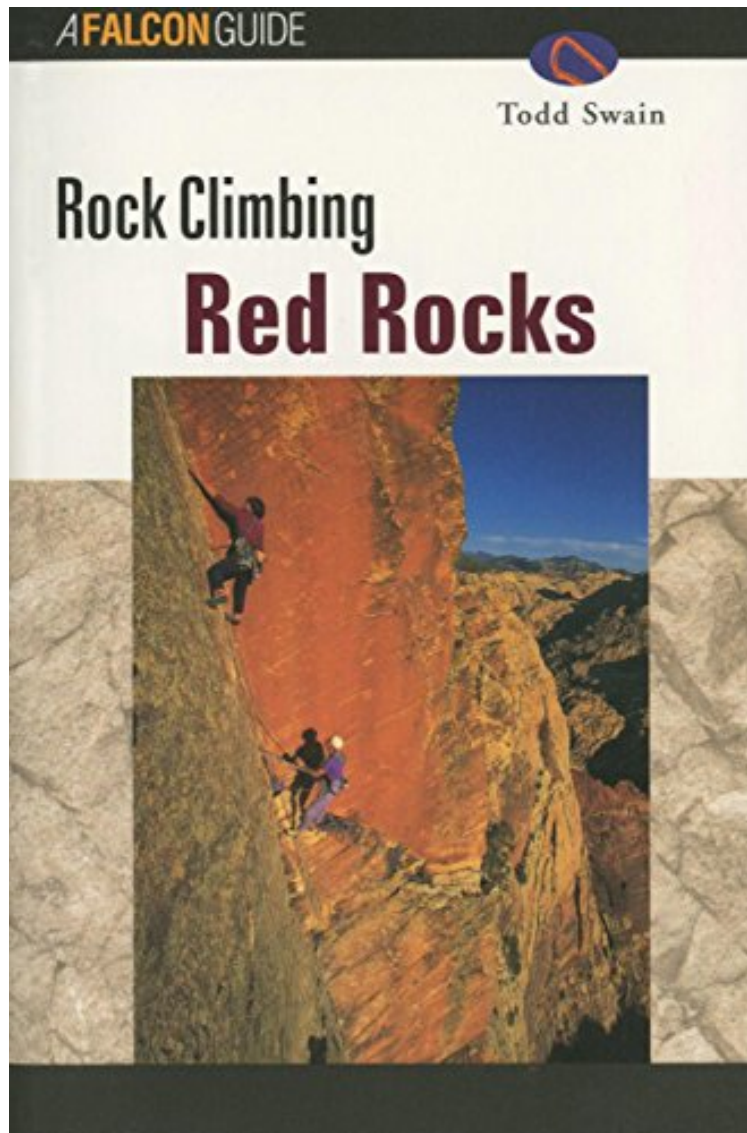

doesn't indicate if climbs are trad, sport, etc. The beginning of the book seems to indicate that everything in it, unless otherwise noted is sport. Yet... This is not the case. Most of the climbs in the book are trad. The routes that are sport there is no indication of how many bolts are in the wall to plan for gear.
