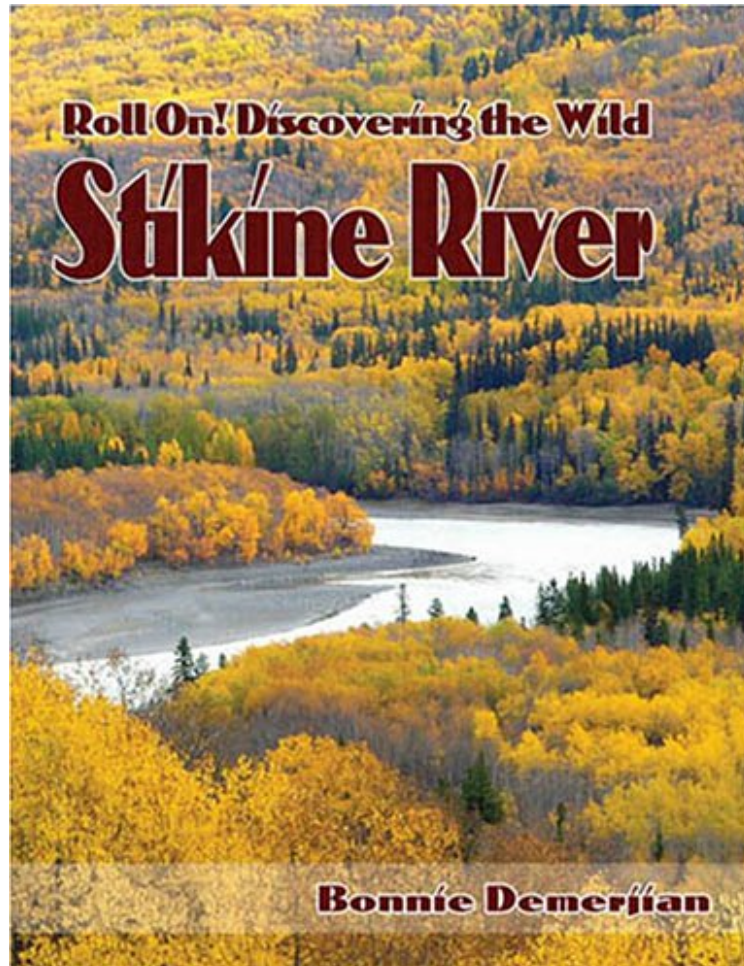

This is a survey of the Stikine River which flows through northern British Columbia and Alaska. This full color book covers the human and natural history of the region as well as some of the colorful people who live and work in this largely pristine country. natural beauty attracts paddlers from around the world. The book includes over 70 color photographs, archival black and white photos and maps.
